HOW TO GET THERE

- The Paediatric Lecture Theatre is on Level 1 of the Sydney Children's Hospital.
- Enter SCH via the High street entrance, Gate 4.
- Walk along the main corridor and turn left into seating area for Starlight Foundation Café.
- Walk up the stairs, turn right and the lecture theatre entrance will be directly on your left.

Car parking: Enter via Barker Street and turn into Easy Street. Rates are from \$3.40 per half hour (or

part thereof) for the first 3 hours, to a maximum of \$20.00

Off Street Parking: Three hour street parking *may* be available on Soudan, St Pauls, Dine or Botany Streets Bus 359 bus stops on Barker Street.

Bus 400 and 370 buses stop on High Street.

Bus 373, 377, 376 and 372 all stop on Belmore Rd around the corner from High St.
