Treatment commenced by Dr or Nurse – time entered in ED IT system

### **Definitions**

**NEAT** – National Emergency Access Target where 90 % of all patients presenting to a public hospital Emergency Department (ED) will either physically leave the ED for admission to hospital, be referred to another hospital for treatment, or be discharged within four hours. **TOC** – Transfer of Care is defined as the transfer of accountability & responsibility for patients from an ambulance paramedic to a hospital clinician

**Triage Seen Time:** Date & time on which the patient is first seen by a Medical Officer or a Nurse working within an approved protocol, guideline or clinical pathway
