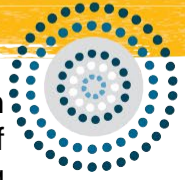


Information for transitioning to Botulinum Toxin – Adult Service at Baringa Private Hospital, Coffs Harbour

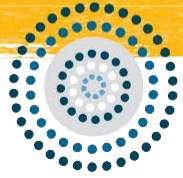

What should you bring to your appointment?

- Medicare card
