How do I conduct an Audit?

To start an Audit, click the pencil icon on the far left of the Audit. This will open the Audit screen at the first patient record of the audit sample.

The Audit auto saves at the point of pressing Next. Navigating away from the screen at any time will save the Audit, and allocate a status of *In Progress*. You can continue from your last point of save at any time by selecting the active Audit from your Inbox.

Once you have finished your Audit, you can select the COMPLETE button. This will set the Status to *Complete* and the Audit becomes read-only. You can still view and navigate through all records of a Complete audit.
