







Chloramphenicol

HOW TO PUT IN YOUR EYE DROPS

<p>1</p> 	<p>Make sure you have the correct eye drops.</p> <p>Wash your hands.</p>	<p>4</p> 	<p>Shut your eye immediately after the drop is in the eye (for approx. 1 minute).</p>
<p>2</p> 	<p>Open the bottle. Pull down your lower eyelid with your finger to form a pocket.</p> <p>Do not allow the tip of the bottle to touch your eye or any other surface.</p>	<p>5</p> 	<p>Wipe away the excess drops from your face and replace the cap onto the bottle.</p> <p>Wash your hands after putting in the eye drops. If you are using more than one bottle of drops wait 3 minutes between each drop</p>
<p>3</p> 	<p>Tilt your head back and look up. Holding the bottle between the thumb and index finger of your other hand, gently squeeze the bottle so that the drop falls into the pocket of the bottom lid.</p>	<p>6</p> 	<p>You need to obtain a new bottle of drops each month, even if it is not empty. This is to prevent infection. Do not stop taking the drops until the doctor tells you. You may need to keep the eye drops in the fridge.</p> <p>Please ask your pharmacist.</p>
