


80% of surveyed staff send patients to private pathology because they couldn't get a home collection and private collection rooms are closer to the patients house... 26% said they refer patients daily

Approx. once a month collectors phone or attend collections where the patient is deceased because they don't know

The HCS only provides services to patients attending the Cancer Care Centre (CCC). There has been no changes to HCS's policy and procedures since starting in 2005. Currently, the HCS is functioning at full capacity and often struggles to meet the average 12 home collection referrals requested by CCC daily (Mon-Fri). In 2018 there was approx. 3,200 paper based home collection requests for home collection. CCC performed approx. 12,180 chemo treatments. utilising 15 chemo chairs.



Nepean Campus Redevelopment - costing \$576M

Funding for redevelopment was allocated to NSW Health - NSW Health Pathology did not receive funds to meet increase demand on the home collection service. Funding needs to be sought from improved revenue.
