NEAT Patient Journey Template



A patient journey template can be used to help determine the reasons for patients staying in the Emergency Department (ED) for longer than 4 hours. Analysis of the time spent throughout a patient journey can assist clinicians evaluate what patients were waiting for and why in certain periods of that journey. This template provides a basic framework to allow you to look at the total length of the patient journey as well as the individual stages to aid in analysis of delays. It can be used for general patient journeys in the ED or for a sub group, e.g. surgical admissions, mental health.
