
# **Innovation Exchange**

# Share your innovations and improvements

to benefit the broader health system

The Innovation Exchange is a collaborative place to share and promote your local innovation and improvement projects to other people in NSW Health.

It is a dynamic knowledge sharing platform, highlighting solutions that can be adapted to suit other local healthcare challenges without the need to duplicate work that has already been done.



#### The Innovation Exchange aims to:

- collect and promote information and resources about current clinical projects, the latest innovations and improvements in healthcare from across NSW and beyond
- deliver a platform for health professionals to learn new ways of delivering healthcare to support local needs and to share their experiences and lessons
- connect health professionals with others who share similar clinical interests to improve healthcare.

The Innovation Exchange is led by the NSW Agency for Clinical Innovation. We support innovations that are person-centred, clinically led, evidence-based and value-driven.



#### Why share your project?

If you have designed or implemented a project that aims to improve healthcare in NSW, the Innovation Exchange is the ideal platform to share your work with a wider audience and highlight the efforts of you and your team.

You will have a webpage on the Innovation Exchange to feature your project so other health professionals can see what you have achieved and work out if it will help them to solve a similar challenge in their organisation or facility.

You don't need to have a completed project to have it published on the Innovation Exchange; we also accept projects that are in the planning or implementation stages.

# Having your project featured on the Innovation Exchange is beneficial because:

- it is an opportunity for you to showcase the innovation and improvement work taking place in your district/service to the rest of NSW Health
- it is an opportunity for collaboration with other NSW Health services
- it is an opportunity to highlight individuals and teams within your workforce who are leading the way in the innovation space.



# **Eligibility criteria**

Once you submit your project to the Innovation Exchange, we will assess it against three criteria:

- 1. The project identifies and addresses a recognised and unmet need
- **2.** The project falls into one of these three categories:
  - a new resource including a model of care, clinical pathway, program, tool or initiative
  - a new procedure or process including a policy, training program, strategy or communication tool
  - an improvement to an existing service or the development of a new one.
- **3.** The project is current and has been developed in the last 12–18 months or is presently implemented.


If your project does not meet the eligibility criteria, we will reach out to discuss the reasons that the project submission was unsuccessful.
