## Below is a list of equipment and medication to keep available for burn management.

Examples
Pharmacological: e.g. paracetamol, ibuprofen
Non-pharmacological: Distraction items (e.g. toys, TV, music, bubbles)
Sterile scissors
Dressing pack
Gloves
PPE: e.g. mask, goggles, gown
Wound swabs
Bowl/kidney dish
Saline
Sterile water
Plastic film: e.g. glad wrap, cling film
Silver: e.g. Acticoat, MepilexAg, AllevynAg
Impregnated gauze: e.g. Bactigras (with antimicrobial), Jelonet, Adaptic, Curity
Hydrocolloid: e.g. Comfeel, Duoderm
Silicone: e.g. Mepilex, Allevyn
Film: Tegaderm
Adhesive woven tape: e.g. Hypafix, Mefix, Fixomul
Webril
Tubular bandage: e.g. Tubigrip, Tubifast
Crepe bandage
Sorbolene
Soft white paraffin
Chlorsig
